The occasion

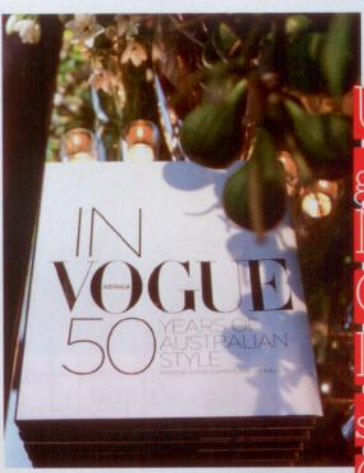
